



**Prof Dr Brian Mishara**

Brian Mishara, Psychology Professor and Director of the Centre for Research and Intervention on Suicide and Euthanasia at the Université du Québec à Montréal, is Vice-chairperson of the Trustees of the helpline network, Befrienders Worldwide. His research focuses on the effectiveness of suicide prevention programmes, how children understand suicide, theories of suicidality, ethical issues, euthanasia and assisted suicide, and evaluations of helpline and internet prevention. A founder of Suicide Action Montreal, the Montreal suicide prevention centre, and a past president of the International Association for Suicide Prevention and Canadian Association for Suicide Prevention, he consults and conducts suicide prevention training internationally and co-edited the 2013 book *Suicide Prevention and New Technologies: Evidence Based Practice*.
