



Prof Rory O'Connor

Rory O'Connor is Professor of Health Psychology at the University of Glasgow in Scotland and President of the International Academy of Suicide Research. He is a registered health psychologist who is broadly interested in self-regulation and health outcomes. Rory leads the Suicidal Behaviour Research Laboratory (Web: www.suicideresearch.info; Twitter: @suicideresearch) at Glasgow, the leading suicide/self-harm research group in

Scotland. He has published extensively in the field of suicide and self-harm, specifically concerning the psychological processes which precipitate suicidal behaviour and self-harm. He is also the UK National Representative for the International Association for Suicide Prevention and a member of the American Association of Suicidology. He serves on the Scientific Review Board of the American Foundation for Suicide Prevention and is an Associate Editor of *Archives of Suicide Research*. He also serves on the Chief Scientist's Office Population and Health Services Research committee, the Scottish Government Self-Harm and National Suicide Prevention Strategy group and the editorial boards of *Suicide and Life-Threatening Behavior*, *Suicidology Online*, *Psychology & Health* and *Journal of Behavioral Medicine*. Rory acts as an advisor to a range of national and international organisations including national governments on the areas of suicide and self-harm.
